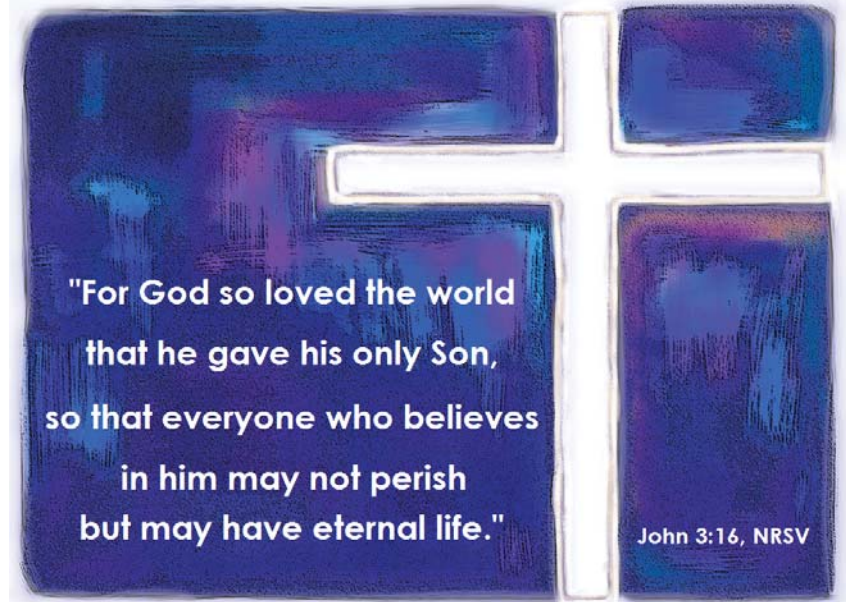

### Qualifications of Deacon

The office of deacon is an office for service to Christ through the church. It is not a position or office to give in order to honor oneself.

In order to qualify for the office of deacon according to the Bible a man shall:

1. Be Spirit filled. (controlled by) Acts 6:5
2. Set a high standard of separated Christian living; for example, shall not drink alcoholic beverages, attend questionable places of amusement, use abusive language, etc. I Timothy 4:12
3. Be active and faithful to all major areas of church life. I Cor. 4:2 and I Tim. 3:11. For example, attend church every Sunday morning and evening, including Sunday School, Wednesday evening, and other meetings, unless hindered by some reason which is approved by one's Christian conscience.
4. Not be a gossip. I Timothy 3:8
5. Believe in and practice "storehouse tithing." Mal. 3:6-11 and I Cor. 16:2
6. Have compassion for the lost and seek through his lifestyle and speech to win the lost to the Lord Jesus Christ. Phillip witnessed to the Samaritans and to the Ethiopian in Acts 8.
7. Be a single man or the husband of one living wife. I Tim. 3:11-12
8. Believe the Bible to be the inspired word of God, without error, the source of authority for preaching and practice. II Tim. 3:16
9. Believe in salvation by grace, through faith; based on the substitutionary death of Christ for all sinners. John 3:16
10. Rule his children and his own house well. I Tim. 3:4
11. Do all in his power to create and preserve harmony in the church.
12. Be able to keep, and have the reputation for keeping in confidence, those things which should not be discussed with others.
13. Recognize the God-given spiritual leadership upon the office of a pastor and seek to serve with the pastor.
14. Should be a man who believes in prayer and Bible study.
15. Should be a man who sincerely believes what Baptists believe.
